


Hello ! How are you ?



Here in Reunion Island, we are all fine ! We are 11-year-old pupils from Montgaillard Middle School in St Denis, Reunion Island. It is a French island in the Indian Ocean.

There are typical musical instruments, for example the « kayamb » and the traditional dances are « Maloya » and « Sega ».




